SECTORS SET TO GAIN:

Agriculture, food processing, textiles & clothing, leather, gems & jewellery, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, engineering goods, electronics, marine/fisheries, furniture & sports goods to gain with massive employment opportunities



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- **Agreement on Social Security** relating to Social Security Contribution also entering into force along with CETA
- This **exempts Indian workers** who temporarily move to the UK and their employers from contributing to the National Insurance Contribution for five years
- Over **75,000** professionals & over **900** companies expected to benefit
- IT, ITeS, financial, professional, healthcare, education, engineering, telecommunication, consultancy services to gain
- Dedicated mobility **opportunities for 1,800** Indian Chefs, Yoga Instructors, Classical Musicians per year
- Services commitments cover all major services sectors & 137 sub sectors
