1. Overview of Boiler Services

This software solution is designed to streamline the management of industrial and commercial boiler services. It aims to improve safety, efficiency, and compliance by digitizing workflows and automating key functions. The system will provide real-time monitoring, maintenance scheduling, and detailed reporting to ensure the continuous and optimal operation of boiler systems.

Purpose of Boiler Renewal under Boiler Act: Boiler registration is valid for 12 months and must be renewed to ensure continued compliance with safety regulations and legal requirements. This renewal process verifies proper inspections and certifications, which are essential for maintaining efficient, safe, and insured operations.

2. How to Get Started

Enter the application URL (<https://oneclick.cgstate.gov.in>) in the browser and the page navigates to the Home page of the SWS application.

3. How to Login

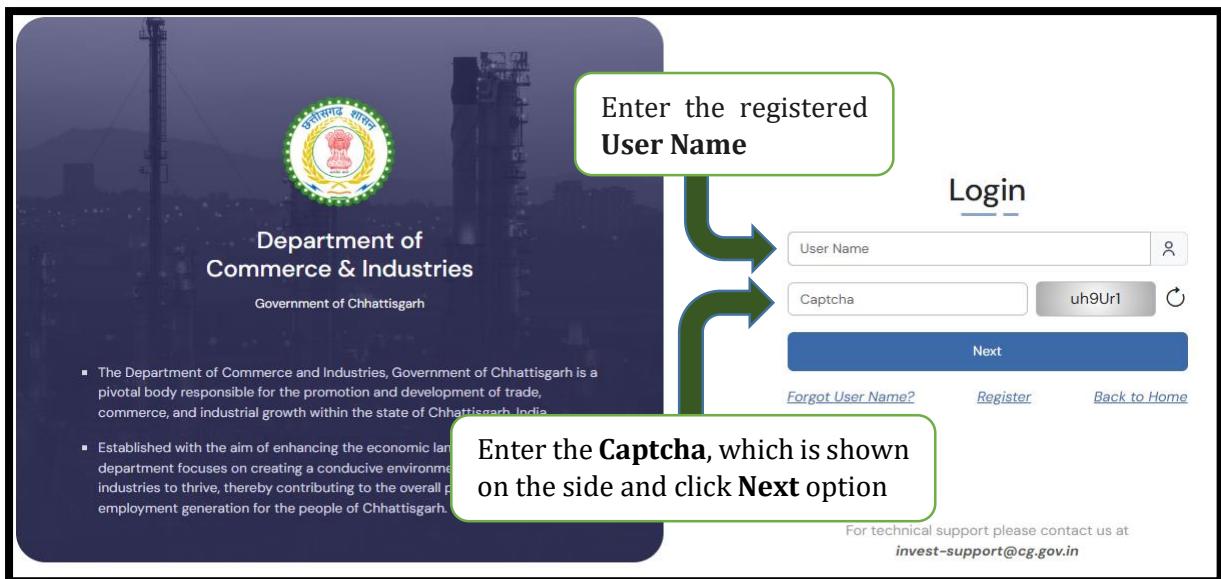


Figure 3.2: Login Screen (A)

The user to login with the credentials into the application in the home and login page as a **Figure 3.1 & 3.2**.




Figure 4.1: Dashboard Screen

After a successful login, the page navigates to the Investor Dashboard (refer to **Fig. 4.1**), which includes step-by-step instructions for applying services.

4.1. Renewal of Boiler





Figure 4.2: Services Screen

On the services page, refer to **Figure 4.2**, which displays all Boiler Inspectorate. In the Application section, select the option to apply for Renewal of Boiler.

After clicking the apply option, a Boiler Renewal Services screen appears in the application, as shown in **Figure 4.3**.

4.1.1. User enter the Boiler Details

- Registered Number of Boiler:** Enter the unique registration number for your boiler.
- Type of Boiler:** Select the boiler type from the dropdown menu.
- Max Continuous Evaporation:** Enter the maximum continuous evaporation rate.
- Select **Yes** or **No** for Small Industry Boiler.
- Enter the Effective Heating Surface Area.
- Working Pressure (Kg / Cm2):** Enter the working pressure.
- Place of Manufacture:** State where the boiler was manufactured.
- Year of Manufacture:** Enter the year the boiler was made.
- Date of Inspection Desirable:** Choose a preferred date for the inspection.

- The user must indicate whether a **Remnant Life Assessment (RLA)** has been conducted by selecting **Yes** or **No**. If **Yes**, specify the year it was completed.
- Mode of Inspection Online under Regulation 376(FF): Yes or No.** If "Yes" the user will be prompted to download Form 19. After filling it out and scanning it, the user must upload the PDF copy.
- Description of the boiler and its age:** The user selects the type of boiler from the dropdown menu.
- Is Repair Required:** Indicate whether a repair is required by selecting either "Yes" or "No".

4.1.2. User enter the Details of Repairs Needed

- **Zone:** Enter the specific area or location where the repairs are needed.
- **Expected Number of Joints:** Enter the estimated number of joints that require repair.
- **Materials:** Enter the specific materials needed to complete the repairs.
- **Size:** Specify the size or dimensions of the materials or joints.
- To add multiple entrepreneur details, click on the “**Add**” option.
- Doing so, the details are displayed in a tabular format.
- If the details entered are not correct, user has the provision to delete the record by clicking the **Delete** () icon.

4.1.3. User enter the Erector Details

- **Service Provider Information:** Enter the service provider's Name and Class.
- **Validity of Erector Certificate:** Enter the expiration date of their certificate.
- **Is Service Provider from Other State:** Select Yes or No to indicate if they are from a different state. If yes, enter their Endorsement Number and the Date it is valid until.

4.1.4. User enter the Welder Details

- Welder Details:** Enter the welder name and the validity date of their certificate.
- Upload Certificate:** Upload the welder certificate.
- Add More:** Click this option to add details for additional welders if needed.
- Doing so, the details are displayed in a tabular format.
- If the details entered are not correct, user has the provision to delete the record by clicking the **Delete** () icon.
- Is Welder Belongs to Other State:** Select **Yes** or **No** to indicate if the welder is from a different state.
- Enter Endorsement Number:** If the welder is from another state, enter their endorsement number.
- Enter Date:** Enter the validity date using the date ticker.

4.1.5. User enter the Boiler Details

User must enter the boiler information, such as Unit Name, Area, District Name, and Pin Code.

4.1.6. User enter the Promoter and Owner Details

- **Promoter & Owner Details:** Enter the promoter Name, Email ID, and Mobile Number.
- **Dated At:** Select the date you are submitting the application.
- **Save:** Click this button to save your application as a draft.
- **Save as Draft:** This button also saves your application as a draft, allowing you to return and complete it later.




Figure 4.10: Successful Pop-up

After clicking the **Save** option, a successful pop-up will appear on the screen as a **Figure 4.10.**




Figure 4.12: Confirmation Pop-up
